

## **REFLECTIONS MONTAGE (the programme is planned according to a 20 minutes timeline)**

### Objective:

To let students recap the ups and downs they have experienced through the 1.5 days of the JC Experience Programme, what they remember the most and how they think of NYJC in a fun way.

### Materials needed:

- 20 Vanguard sheets (1 per group)
- 20 pads of Post-its (1 per group)
- 1 pack of blu-tack

### Students are encouraged to bring:

- Markers and colour pens
- Magazines
- Scissors
- Glue / tape

### Method of reflections:

Each group will be given a piece of vanguard sheet and a pad of post-its. They are required to write down their reflections in a fun and creative way to be showcase to all at the end of the day.

### Procedure:

Group facilitators will be given instructions on the first day of the programme of the reflections montage and to remind their group members to bring the materials required on the next day.

On the actual day, the giving out of materials will be to the group facilitators at the time they enter hall for the last part of the programme.

About 3 minutes of the time would be spent on introducing the REFLECTIONS MONTAGE to the students. (refer to introduction speech below)

Then, groups are given about 15mins to complete their reflections and facilitators would collect it back to hand over to the in-charge.

The reflections would then be judged within the time where VP is making closing address. Final score would be computed into the point they earned through the AMAZING RACE for the final result for prize giving.

Then, the reflections will be pasted around the hall and students are encouraged to view the REFLECTIONS MONTAGE at the end of the programme.

It will be removed when the hall is cleared of students.

### Point system:

1<sup>st</sup> - 200

2<sup>nd</sup> - 150

3<sup>rd</sup> - 100

Rest - 50 each

Judging criteria:

- Creativity
- Depth of reflections
- Aesthetics appeal

Judges:

JEPA members who are free at that time.

Introduction speech for REFLECTIONS MONTAGE:

Before we let this enjoyable event come to an end, we shall give you one last chance to earn points to get attractive prizes for the group you are with for these 1.5 days, through the REFLECTIONS MONTAGE. We now invite you to make a recollection on the ups and downs, the relationships made, what you think of the school, what happened that etched deeply in your mind and anything else that you want to say to your group mates and everyone present or anything else about this experience programme that you have gone through. Your group facilitators shall now give you more instructions to carry out the final group task for the JC experience programme.

Instructions for group facilitators:

- There will be the REFLECTIONS MONTAGE at the end of day 2 for students to reflect on the ups and downs they have experienced through the 1.5 days of the JC Experience Programme, what they remember the most and how they think of NYJC by putting them down in words.
- It will be carried out in a competition style, where point will be added towards the final points they have earned in the Amazing Race, to give them a final chance to earn their award.
- Each group will be provided with a pad of post-its and a vanguard sheet. Group facilitators will collect them when they enter the hall for the final programme of the day.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own materials to decorate their reflections montage. Some suggested materials are scissors, glue/tapes, magazines and colour pens or markers. They may want to bring photos if they want.
- Each group will be given approximately 15 minutes to complete their work.
- The work will be judged on creativity and the in depth of the reflections made.
- The reflections will be put up in the hall at the end of the day. Students are encouraged to view them before leaving for home.
